2. NanoGraft

NanoGraft is working to restore sensation and reduce phantom limb pain in lower limb amputees through a wearable device that stimulates the nerves and allows the person to feel the ground. Up to 80% of amputees suffer from phantom limb pain and have a fear of falling due to instability when walking. Current prosthetic legs offer no sensory stimulus and pain medication is ineffective for phantom limb pain. NanoGraft are developing this device with input from the amputee community in order to deliver a tailored solution that best meets their needs with a versatile and affordable solution.

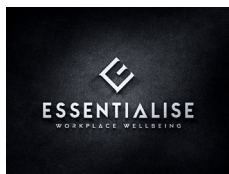
3. Yhangry

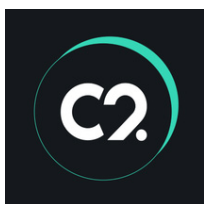

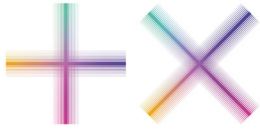

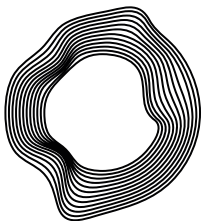
